Information for Unpaid Carers

'In Somerset you are considered to be a 'CARER' as opposed to a 'Paid Carer' or 'Microprovider', if you give up your time without pay, to look after a family member, a friend, or a neighbour who is ill, frail or has a disability. You can be a parent carer, a young carer, or care for an older person or other adult with care needs.' An Unpaid Carer can be in receipt of a Government allowance or benefit and still be an unpaid Carer.
